PUBLIC HEALTH

We expect, if you are coming in person. that:

1) you will have been vaccinated for covid according to the advice of your local public health authority or sound medical advice specific to you if your own medical condition warrants such advice; and that

2)) you will have followed any isolation advice that you may have been given.

At this point, masking is recommended.

PARKING

The parking lot at the church is small (about 5 spaces), which we shall reserve for people with mobility issues who are driving themselves to the church.

On street parking next to our home can usually fit at least 5 cars.

Please let me know if you need to use one of those spaces either at the church or by our home.

All other people coming by car, including those who are dropping off people with mobility issues, should plan to park in the neighbourhood and leave 5-15 minutes to walk to the church once parked.

There is usually plenty of free parking.

ACCESSIBILITY FOR PEOPLE WHO HAVE DIFFICULTY WITH STAIRS

For those parking at the church, or dropping people off there, you should be aware that 127 St, is one way for cars going north.

The sanctuary is on the street side of the church; the hall is on the alley side.

The doors to the sanctuary and one of the doors to the hall are off the parking lot and at ground level.

The hall is up a small set of stairs and there is a wheelchair lift beside the stairs

Both rooms can accommodate wheelchairs.

Our yard, when accessed from 110 Ave., is at sidewalk/driveway level and the yard is accessible for wheel chairs that can be wheeled over grass.

Unfortunately, accessing the interior of our home requires being able to go up about 4-5 steps, and the interior is not set up for wheelchair use.

ATTENDANCE BOOK

There will be an attendance book to sign.

From a few minutes before the funeral begins to a few minutes after it ends, it will be at the back of the sanctuary

Otherwise, while we are at the church, it will be next to the coffee table in the church hall.

The book will be scanned and, along with its online counterpart, will be posted to debbiandrews.ca

CONSENT TO BE RECORDED

It is possible that you may be recorded during the funeral or celebration.

We shall presume that your attendance implies your consent to this.
